Thank you for reaching out to the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) with your concerns about potential Harmful Algal Blooms caused by 'Blue Green Algae' in Minnesota waters.

## ATTENTION!!!

If you (or your pet) are currently experiencing any severe symptoms from a potential harmful algae bloom exposure, please seek immediate medical or veterinary attention. Your health and safety are the most important. Symptoms observed outside normal behavior may include:

- Frequent or sustained nausea / vomiting / diarrhea
- Sudden or prolonged sleepiness/laziness
- Loss of desire to eat or drink
- Stumbling, pupil dilation, drooling, seizures, or other signs of neurological stress (Animals)
- Severe skin rashes or sudden respiratory symptoms (humans)

Please instruct your medical Doctor (MD) or pet's Veterinarian (DMV) to share your report with the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) Food and Waterborne Illness hotline **as soon as possible** so we can gather needed information to determine if a site visit is possible. *Time is critical to catch the bloom before it changes condition or location*.
