

# RLAA Slow/No Wake buoys

Rice Lake Area Association volunteers installed three (3) 'Slow/No Wake' buoys on Rice Lake/Elm Creek this season.

This map illustrates the locations for the three (3) Slow/No Wake buoys which the Rice Lake Area Association placed on Rice Lake and Elm Creek.

These buoys have been deployed based on past feedback from residents about some watercraft not obeying the 150' from shoreline no wake rule.

- 1 – Across from Arboretum on Elm Creek
- 2 – NE corner of lake by Tristan Bay
- 3 – Entrance/Exit from Boat Ramp Bay

There is also a white round buoy marking the high spot in the NW corner of the lake.

A large red round buoy has been set out this year marking the “old road” crossing between the NE tip of 88<sup>th</sup> Place and Harbor Lane and 91<sup>st</sup> Ave N. This buoy designates a high spot which may come into play during drought conditions for deep draft watercraft.
